Welcome to the Department of the Environment, Tourism, Science and Innovation's (the department) online grant application service for the Queensland-German Bioeconomy Collaborative Science Program 2026-2027. The program will support up to four Queensland applicants under the Queensland application process, who will be awarded a grant of up to \$250,000 (excluding GST) for a project period up to three years.
